COURSE OUTLINE FOR TWO-DAY INTERMEDIATE/ADVANCED WORKSHOP

This course is recommended for those who have attended the one-day course held the previous day or have taken Junko's course in the past.

Let's experience Japanese ink art, Sumi-e. Japanese ink art is a philosophy, a way of living and an art form.

In this course, you will prepare your own ink and then learn to use different Sumi ink tones and brush techniques to create Japanese ink painting (Sumi-e) with various subjects including Australian birds and plants.

You will be provided with many different subjects to choose from, such as plants, flowers, landscapes, waterfalls, gum trees, cockatoos, kookaburras, and cats. You will learn to feel and capture the meaning of objects from nature with your interpretation. Then you will express the objects variously with brush pressure, rhythm, tones and confidence in your strokes. You'll not only learn brush stroke techniques but also experience the whole process and understand yourself through your work.
